Alternate Care Site: alternate care sites (ACS) where patients with COVID-19 can receive medical care for the duration of their isolation period. COVID-19 Testing by County

Charleston County: Monday, Friday and Saturday from May 15-30 (**No Memorial Day testing**) **Non-invasive testing is by appointment only to qualifying individuals. To register, visit www.harristeeter.com/covidtesting.** Testing will be held at the North Charleston PAC (Lot C), 5001 Coliseum Dr., N. Charleston, SC 29418.

Chester County: Wednesdays and Fridays from 10:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m. (May 27 & 29; June 3 & 5). No appointment is necessary and it will be held at the “Backlot” in downtown Chester, South Carolina (139 Cadz Street) behind True Value & Black’s Drugs (off Church Street). Tests will be administered by MUSC Chester.

Fairfield County: Mondays and Wednesdays from 9:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m. **Testing is by appointment only by calling 1-803-722-1822.** Vulnerable populations, those with underlying health conditions, and anyone with symptoms will be tested. This drive-Up testing will be held at 1136 Kincaid Bridge Road in Winnsboro, South Carolina (behind Italian Garden). Tests will be administered by Eau Claire Cooperative Health.

York County: Fridays from 10:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m. (starting May 22). No appointment is necessary and it will be held at Clinton Chapel AME Zion in Western York County (302 California Street, downtown York, South Carolina (near the intersection with Hwy 321). Tests will be administered by Affinity Health Center, Rock Hill.
