EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The SC Commission for Minority Affairs was created to:

- Provide the minority community, consisting of African Americans, Native American Indians, Hispanics/Latinos, Asians and others with a single point of contact for statistical data and technical assistance in the areas of research and planning for a greater economic future;
- Work with officials on the state, county and local levels of government in disseminating statistical data and determining its impact on their constituencies;
- Provide for publication of a statewide statistical abstract on minority affairs;
- Provide statistical analyses for members of the General Assembly on the status of minority communities as the State experiences economic growth and changes;
- Establish advisory committee's representative of minority groups as deemed appropriate to advise the Commission;
- Act as liaison with the business community to provide programs and opportunities for minorities;
- Research the causes and effects of minority socioeconomic deprivation in the State;
- Seek federal and other funding on behalf of the State of South Carolina for the express purpose of implementing various programs and services for African Americans, Native American Indians, Hispanics/Latinos, Asians, and other minority groups; and
- Promulgate regulations as may be necessary to carry out the State Recognition process of Native American Indian entities in the State of South Carolina.

The *SC Hispanic Resource Directory* has been developed to serve as a tool with information for organizations/agencies wishing to work specifically with the Hispanic community. This directory provides the reader with a brief summary of each organization as well as contact information for that organization. This directory was created with the assistance of the members of the Hispanic Advisory Committee and our Hispanic Program Intern. A special thanks to all the committee members for their assistance and recommendations. This directory includes icons that represent specific focus areas - Health, Education, Advocacy, Business, Culture, and Arts.
